

Asset Naming Convention in ISO CAMS

Purpose

Companies who want to participate in the ISO-administered markets must register those assets with ISO New England for settlement and other market-related purposes. When registering an asset in ISO-NE CAMS, please follow the naming conventions established for market assets in Versant Power's service territory.

Policy

CAMS requires a unique name that is not used by any other asset and a 30-character limit. The convention for assets in Versant's BHD (Bangor Hydro District) territory is to use "Bangor Hydro" or "BHE" or "BHD". Do not use the words "Versant Power" or "Versant". Avoid any trademarks, offensive, derisive, or annoying words, or terms that could create market confusion.
